GC NN Rules for membership 2010

- From GCNN Terms – see www.gcnordic.net
- Key membership principles:
 - Business Network - no NGOs and no IGOs as members
 - However, close co-op with NGOs and IGOs case-by-case
 - Consultants OK (no acquisition)
 - Subsidiaries OK
- UNDP Nordic Office is a member (no fee)
- No micros (less than 10 workers)
- No media (Chatman House rules in sessions)
- Transparency considered case-by-case



Financials

- New membership fee in 2010: 650 €
- Companies who join after first meeting: ½ price
- Branches in different countries pay individual membership fees
- Additional persons (more than 2) from each company to join each meeting: 200 € / extra participant
- Invoices 2010 to be sent out in May 2010 by Finland
- Finance: 15.800 € per 5.5.2010
